When the home page loads, there are five tabs across the page:

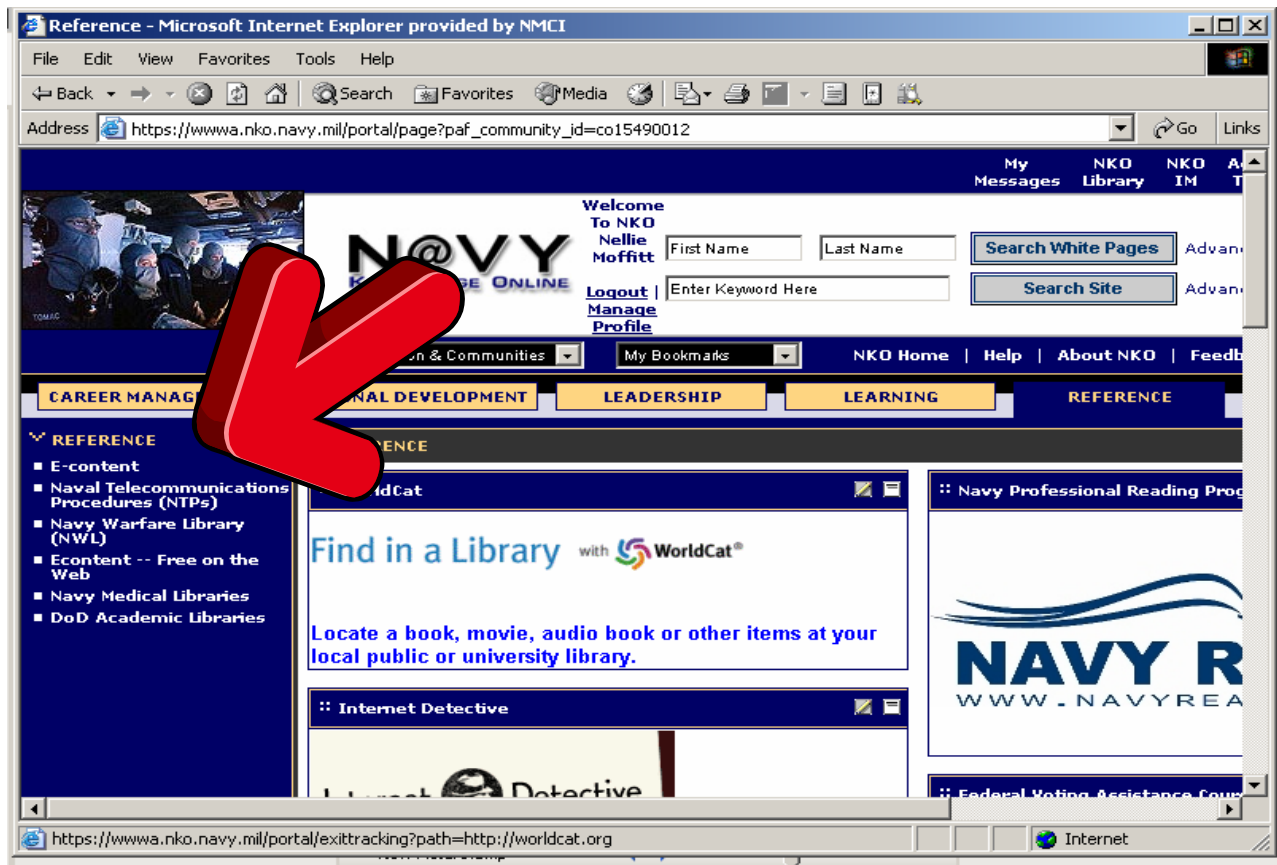
The link to Navy Library E-content SHOULD be right below the Reference Tab

Download the Overdrive Media Console software to your computer

Therefore, you can download the files, but you will have to do it from your home computer. A review of these restrictions is being made, and we will advise you when and if the situation changes.)
